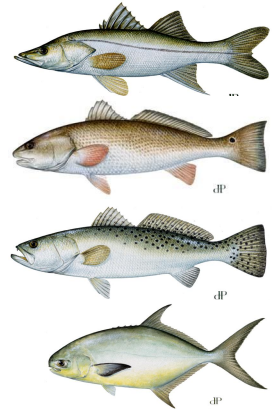

**Entry Fees, Plaques, Prizes:** \$35 per angler, \$40 at Anglers' Meeting  
Open **and** Pro/Licensed Guide Division  
Plaques, prizes for 36 winners  
Separate Youth Division, 12/under, no entry fee



**“OPEN” Treasure Slam Champion:** Angler with most aggregate inches of all four species, using the longest single fish of each species—snook, redfish, trout, pompano. If no one catches all four, the winner will be the longest aggregate of any of the species. One grand prize for Treasure Slam winner. Treasure Slam winner's name to be engraved on perpetual trophy.

**PRO Champion:** Licensed Guide with most aggregate inches of all four species, using the longest single fish of each species—snook, redfish, trout, pompano. Fish must meet legal minimums. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place prizes will be awarded.

**Eight Division Winners: Longest Fish, One Entry Per Angler per division**

SNOOK (min. 27 in.)  
REDFISH (min. 18 in.)  
TROUT (min. 15 in.)  
POMPANO (min. 11 in. fork)

FLOUNDER (min. 12 in.)  
SHEEPSHEAD (min. 12 in.)  
BLACK DRUM (min 14 in.)  
TARPON (most releases, any length)

**Bonus Fly Awards:** to be awarded for fish caught on fly in four categories – snook, redfish, trout, tarpon. Fish caught on fly are eligible for Fly Fishing Bonus Award in addition to being eligible in the Grand Slam and Division categories. Anglers are limited to **one** Fly Award each. The four Fly Fishing Bonus Awards will be for the longest snook, redfish and trout and for the most tarpon releases. Anglers **must note** “fly” beside the species name on the official catch report. The Fly Fishing category is for **non-pro** anglers only.

**Bonus Kayak Awards:** for fish caught from a kayak in three categories—snook, redfish and trout, in addition to being eligible in the Grand Slam & Division categories. Anglers are limited to **one** Kayak Award each. The three Kayak Bonus Awards will be for the longest snook, redfish and trout. Anglers **must note** “kayak” on their official catch report. The Kayak category is for **non-pro** anglers only.

**Note:** Slam winner and Pro/Licensed Guides are **not** eligible for Species Division Awards. Anglers limited to **one** 1<sup>st</sup> place division award and/or **two** awards overall.

**Youth Division:** Most total inches, any fish species, angler must be accompanied by adult entered as an angler. (Kids 12 and under may enter adult division **with** entry fee).

Entry fee includes BBQ-Fish Fry, awards party, music, 3:30 p.m. Sunday, June 24, at Florida Oceanographic Coastal Center. Extra BBQ-Fish Fry tickets for anglers' guests available for \$5.00. BBQ-Fish Fry tickets to the public \$10.00.

Anglers to receive disposable cameras, lawsticks and angler bags at anglers' meeting. Each fish must be photographed **immediately** after catch **beside lawstick** to show length. First 200 anglers registered for tournament receive angler bags.

Cameras must be **dropped off** before 5 p.m. at **designated sites** on the day of the tournament.

Standard IGFA rules and state laws apply, judges' decisions final.
