



Coastal Discovery Summer Camp 2010

Discover the wonders of Hutchinson Island, a barrier island located between America's most bio-diverse estuary, the Indian River Lagoon, and the immense Atlantic Ocean. Campers will experience a variety of aquatic and terrestrial ecosystems, conduct relevant science experiments, and interact with Florida Oceanographic's wide array of live marine animals. Instruction and activities will focus on conservation of natural habitats and learning about a variety of plant and animal species. Daily hands-on, feet-wet experiences are designed to inspire curiosity and creativity.

Sea Creature Discovery Camp (SC)

Spend a week discovering animals from the marine world! Campers will...

- ...touch a sting ray, and learn about sharks.
- ...investigate the habitat of fishes by dip-netting and seining in the Indian River Lagoon.
- ...explore the world of echinoderms by interacting with a sea urchin and a brittle star.
- ...observe oysters under the microscope, and find out how they help the environment.

Encounter sea creatures up-close during this week of fun, interactive scientific discovery!

Coastal Ecosystems Discovery Camp (CE)

Explore the coastal habitats that surround us! Campers will...

- ...get their feet wet dip netting and seining in the sea grass beds of the estuary.
- ...collect tiny plankton and observe them under the microscope.
- ...investigate the beach, learning about sand and sea shells.
- ...travel through a mangrove swamp, discovering the plants and animals that thrive there.

Venture into our coastal ecosystems, during this week of exciting, hands-on scientific discovery!

Drop Off/Pick Up Policy:

-Parent/guardian must sign children in and out with a staff member every day

-Please bear in mind your child will be missing out on quality experiences if not dropped off in time

Cancellation Policy:

Cancellations made more than two weeks prior to your camp session will be refunded, minus a \$25 administrative fee. No refunds will be given if registration is cancelled within two weeks of your camp session.

Camper Conduct:

Campers are expected to obey and respect Florida Oceanographic staff and rules.
